

Extracurricular Dance Programme 2023

RI has a long history of offering Dance as an extracurricular activity. This year we have made a few changes to how we administer this programme and we are excited to once again be offering this opportunity to our young people.

The following is an outline of the Dance groups being offered at Remuera Intermediate this year. All groups are open to both boys and girls. Experience is an advantage for all troupes but not necessary. There are two types of groups and full details are provided further below.

Auditioned Troupes Most groups will be auditioned & interested students will need to attend all

auditions &/or recalls.

Non-Audition Groups Students who are interested in these will need to attend an audition time to sign up

but won't need to audition to be in this.

Note, when dance styles have more than one troupe, we class them as either a 'competition' or a 'performance' troupe. The Competition Troupe is considered the elite troupe out of the two. However, all troupes are given the opportunity to compete in at least one event during the year.

Students who make it into groups need to ensure they can attend all rehearsals and commit until the end of the year. This is important as often dances are choreographed specifically for the numbers involved. As such fees are non-refundable so please be sure you and your child are prepared to commit for the year.

The dance programme is coordinated by Brianna King. Margaret Khoong, the school business manager, oversees finances and communication with families. Should you have any queries about this programme please email Brianna in the first instance brainnak@remint.school.nz.

Fees

For all groups, there is a one-off non-refundable fee of \$350 per troupe for the year. This fee covers all costs except transport and/or accommodation in relation to competitions.

After the auditions are completed, parents will be emailed to offer their child a place in the relevant troupe and they will be issued an invoice via the parent portal. Payment details are included in the confirmation email. To confirm your child's place you must pay the fee in full by Friday 26 May.

As we have a pay-before-you-play policy, if payment is not received by the due date your child will be withdrawn and their spot may go to another student on the waitlist.
